By the time he was 30, he had successful businesses in finance. The traumatic events of COVID made him realize, **"I want to reconnect with God and apply His commandments."** Soon, he began having recurring dreams that reminded him of a lesson from Scripture – if you keep God's commandments, He will manifest Himself to you.

In one of his dreams, Angel was given the name of someone he should meet. He later found out that person was at Long Beach Rescue Mission. Angel sensed God was calling him to come here... even though it meant leaving everything he knew.

Guided by his faith in God, Angel joined our New Life Program and has found serving and engaging with Mission guests very rewarding. The experience has been humbling and it has inspired him to pursue a new career and study psychology and pre-med.

"The Mission taught me that money isn't everything," he says. **"I enjoy serving others, but I want to serve others in a different way.** That's why I want to go into the medical field."

Yet children experiencing homelessness are robbed of this time. Without the stability of a safe home, they lose confidence in themselves and lose hope for their future.



construction underway!

Long Beach Rescue Mission is committed to providing safe shelter and support for our neighbors in need... especially those who are most often overlooked: women, young adults and children.

We're excited to announce that we broke ground on



Timothy House, our transitional age youth shelter for men 18-24 years old. It will have 12 beds and offer our 1-year New Life Program for young men who have aged out of the foster care system.

Construction is also underway on Lydia House. It will have 60 new beds, doubling our current capacity so that no woman or child facing abuse, addiction, financial hardship or abandonment is ever turned away. This 3-story safe haven will feature:

- a gym to promote healthy bodies and minds
- a multipurpose room for activities like fellowship and worship
- a patio area for peaceful reflection and connection with God and community
